Receive a cordial greeting from the Technical Secretariat and the National Committee of the 8th World Social Forum on Migrations, which will take place from November 2nd to 4th of this year in the venue of the Tlatelolco University Cultural Center, in the City of Mexico.

The WSFM is a process in permanent, horizontal and decentralized construction that assumes autonomy, self-management and self-sufficiency as organizational principles. Through different expressions, the construction of a new vision of migration is sought, through a social process in favor of the defense of the rights of migrants and their families, which strengthens dialogues between social networks and migrants and capacity to influence public policy decisions to promote inclusion, respect, equality, recognition and appreciation of differences. For this, it is sought to involve the migrant population, and also the people who live in the communities of origin, transit, destination and return; the students, the human rights defenders, and the population in general.

This year, the thematic axes are: 1. Human, labor and union rights, social inclusion, hospitality and mobility; 2. realities of borders, walls and other barriers; 3. resistances, actors, movements and collective actions; 4. systemic crisis of capitalism and its consequences for migration; 5. migration, gender and body; 6. migration, rights of mother nature, climate change and North-South disputes, and 7. diasporas, transnational communities and active migrant population.

In this perspective, we send this letter of invitation, so that you can carry out the relevant visa and travel procedures for your participation in the 8th WSFM. Remember that you must complete the registration form to facilitate your participation and, if you wish, announce activities initiatives.
